MUSIC AT THE BASILICA

Music for the Fourth Sunday of Easter

This Sunday is also known as Good Shepherd Sunday, and the readings and music reflect that theme. The Communion motet is an unusual three-part motet by Pietro Vinci (c. 1525–1584), an Italian composer of late Renaissance music. Vinci was probably born in Nicosia, Sicily. He is seen by some as a founder of a Sicilian school of composers, and served in various Sicilian cities as Maestro di cappella. He was active in Bergamo, in northern Italy, in Lombardy, as well. Bergamo has a prominent place in music history. The large Romanesque church of Santa Maria Maggiore, with which Vinci was associated, was begun in 1137, and has a continuous and well-documented 800-year tradition of music teaching and singing. When the town was under Venetian control, the musical style of the Venetians was imported as well; large instrumental ensembles grew up to support the choral singing, with polyphony using two organs, brass and viols, a sound which flourished in the fine acoustic environment of Santa Maria Maggiore. Vinci published several books of madrigals and church music from 1561 to 1584.

Our Offertory is a jubilant Jubilate Deo for Eastertide, handled in Mozartian fashion. The Kyrie and Agnus Dei at the 12:45 PM Mass are from a rare Mass of another Italian, Claudio Casciolini (1697-1760). From April 1726 until his death, he worked at the Basilica of San Lorenzo in Damaso in Rome, where he was likely maestro di capella. Finally, a note about the postlude: a Tiento is a diverse, imitative musical genre originating specifically in Spain in the mid-15th century. It is formally analogous to the fantasia found in England, Germany, and the Low Countries, and also the ricercare, first found in Italy. The word derives from the Spanish verb tentar (meaning either to touch, to tempt or to attempt), and was originally applied to music for various instruments. By the end of the 16th century the tiento was exclusively a keyboard form, and especially for the organ.

Stained Glass Windows

With great joy, four refurbished windows will be installed this coming week in the sanctuary area, two windows on each side. Keep in mind, that the restoration of the windows is a monumental effort since that tracery sections of the windows (the woodwork that frames the stained glass) had to be hand hewn from hard wood. This had to be replaced because the old frames and tracery were so deteriorated that they no longer could safely hold the glass in place. The remaining stained glass windows will be completed over the spring and summer.

The stained glass that you now see is the same glass that was there before the restoration. The glass looks new because each piece was cleaned and in some cases replaced where there were breaks or pieces missing.

Weekday Masses

As a result of the work being done inside and outside the Basilica during the installation of the four stained glass windows, the church will be closed from Monday to Friday for the next two weeks. The weekday Masses - 8:00AM & 12:10PM - will be celebrated in St. Michael's Russian Catholic Church at 266 Mulberry Street.

HOLY DOORS OF MERCY

The Basilica of St. Patrick's Old Cathedral is honored, with the blessing of Cardinal Dolan, to have HOLY DOORS at its sister church, the Shrine Church of the Most Precious Blood for the duration of the Holy Year. With these Holy Doors open 24hrs a day, pilgrims passing through them will benefit from indulgences and blessings. Pilgrims will reflect on the major theme of the Holy Year – *the universal reach of God's mercy* – by viewing a display of *presepio*, crafted in this city of Naples by La Scarabattola.

For those in a state of grace and fulfilling the other prescribed conditions, a *plenary indulgence* may be gained once day by passing through the Holy Doors. A plenary indulgence removes all punishment due to sin.

Those seeking the indulgence are encouraged to begin a pilgrimage starting at the Basilica of St. Patrick's Old Cathedral where a Prayer of Mercy may be said. The pilgrim then may proceed down to the Shrine Church of the Most Precious Blood where the Holy Doors of Mercy are located.

MPB'S GIRL SCOUT TROOP NEWS:


Congratulations to the Girl Scouts of Troop
