FIGLI DI SAN GENNARO: The Figli di San Gennaro (The Sons and Daughters of San Gennaro) has gifted Most Precious Blood Church/St. Patrick' Old Cathedral with a donation of \$12,000, part of the profits from the 2016 Festival.

MASS FOR A NEW YORK CITY HERO: The Mass intention on Wednesday, February 1st, is for Detective Steven McDonald who recently passed away at age 59 from a heart attack. Detective McDonald was the Police Officer who was shot in Central Park 30 years ago. While the bullet did not kill him, it ended his life as he knew it. He remained paralyzed from the neck down; he lived out his life in a wheelchair, breathing through a tube and speaking through a mechanical device. He proved just how great a human being he was when he announced some time after this tragedy that he forgave his assailant. Detective McDonald spent the next 30 years of his life as a spokesperson for the NYPD, serving as an advocate promoting peace, understanding and forgiveness. The Mass is being sponsored by Court Officer Joey Angiel who regularly visits our seniors during their weekly Wednesday get-togethers. May Detective McDonald rest in peace, and may his family be blessed with God's loving and comforting grace.

RENOVATION WORK TO BEGIN

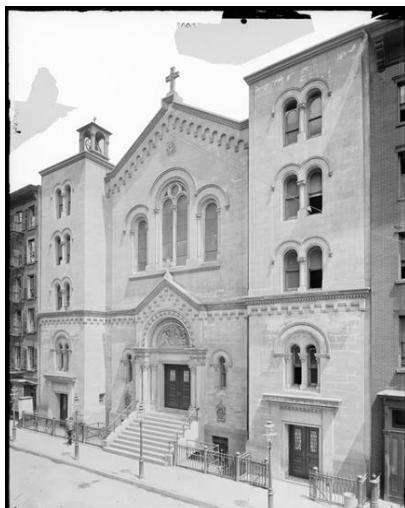
