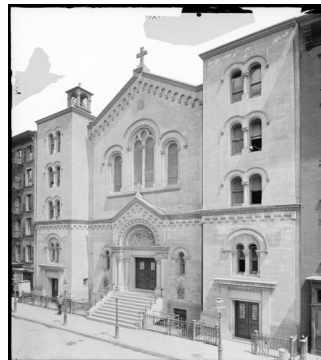

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME: It is time to change our clocks again. Sunday, March 12, 2017 at 2:00AM is when Daylight Savings Time begins. At 2:00AM you will be changing the time on your watches/clocks FORWARD one hour to 3:00AM. Of course, for those who cannot stay up that late you can change the time before going to bed or when you get up the next morning – just please don't forget to do it. For people who have cell phones, computers and/or a cable box, the times on these devices change automatically; therefore, if you are unsure of what the time actually is, just check one of the items mentioned above and that will tell you what you need to know.

The Fridays of Lent

are days of abstinence from eating meat.

The universal law of the church prohibits Roman Catholics from eating meat on the Fridays of Lent. Abstinence obliges all those who have reached the age of 14 and continues to oblige throughout their lives. Those who are not specifically obliged to abstain from eating meat are encouraged to join in the discipline of abstaining to the extent that they are able.
