WAY OF THE CROSS IN THE STREETS OF LITTLE ITALY: The Basilica of St. Patrick's Old Cathedral will sponsor the Way of the Cross through the streets on Good Friday from 4:30PM to 5:30PM.

WAY OF THE CROSS OVER THE BROOKLYN BRIDGE: On Good Friday, April 14th, Communion & Liberation will sponsor the Way of the Cross over the Brooklyn Bridge. Participants will congregate for the first station at St. James Cathedral, Brooklyn, at 10:00AM. St. James Cathedral is located at 250 Cathedral Place at the corner of Jay and Tillary Streets.) After a station on the Brooklyn Bridge, the procession will follow the cross to a third station at City Hall Park in Manhattan, and a fourth station near Ground Zero. The final station will be at St. Peter's Church, on Barclay Street, concluding at 1:30PM. At each station, there will be readings from the Passion, a meditation, a reflection and hymns.
