Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence:

Fasting Requires only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day to maintain physical strength, but these two meals together should not equal a full meal in quantity. Nor is there eating between meals. Fasting obliges all those who have reached the age of 18 and continues to oblige through age 59. Those who are not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able.

Friday Abstinence prohibits the eating of meat of Catholics who are 14 years of age and older, throughout their lives. Prohibits individuals from eating meat on a particular day. **Friday Abstinence During Lent**
