**ONGOING DEVOTIONS:** The Novena in honor of Saint Anthony continues every Tuesday after the 12:10PM Mass. The 13-week novena ends June 6th. There will be a Mass on Tuesday, June 13th which is Saint Anthony's feast day; that Mass will be at 12:10PM, as well.

**MUSIC & VOICES CONCERT SERIES:** Information about this concert is a bit slow coming in. We do know that it will be held on Wednesday, April 26th from 7:00PM to 8:30PM. The theme for April's concert is Joyous Spring (Primavera Gioiosa in Italian). This month's concert is being sponsored by James LaMorte. James is the proprietor of the market that is held in our courtyard on Mulberry Street every Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday (weather permitting). As always, the producer is William Russo, and the artistic director is Kim Kalesti, also one of the performers at these concerts. There is a SUGGEST DONATION of \$10.00 to help support our music programs.

**TRIANGLE SHIRTWAIST FACTORY MEMORIAL MASS:** There will be a tribute to honor the victims who perished in this horrific fire back on March 25, 1911. The tribute will be during our 5:30PM Saturday vigil Mass on April 29, 2017. The victims ranged from 14 – 43 years of age – the majority were in their early teens and twenties. Many victims were from Little Italy and the lower East Side.

Approximately 500 women, mostly young Italian and Jewish immigrants, worked in the factory which occupied the top floors of a building in Greenwich Village. They worked for approximately \$15 a week – 146 did not make it out alive. No one knows exactly what happened, but it is believed that someone dropped either a match or a lit cigarette. There was no sprinkler system, and only one small working elevator. The door leading to the outside was locked – some say the factory owner locked it to keep union organizers out. The fire escape broke under the weight of the desperate workers trying to escape. Many jumped out of windows to escape and fell to their deaths.

It is said that there is a silver lining in every situation, even one as tragic as this one. The silver lining here is the passing of 36 new fire & safety regulations intended to prevent another horrific inferno, as well as child labor laws as many of the fire victims were very young teenagers. Please mark this date on your calendars. This past March 25th marked the 106th anniversary of this tragedy.
