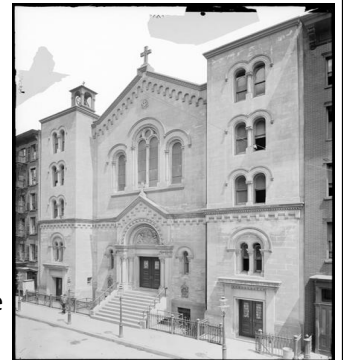

ORDER SONS (& DAUGHTERS) OF ITALY IN AMERICA [OSIA]:

Today OSIA is holding its annual Mass in our church, marking the 112th anniversary. OSIA was first established right here in Little Italy, New York City, at 203 Grand Street. Every year after their Mass, members and followers of OSIA walk the few blocks to Grand Street to lay a wreath at the original location.



OSIA officers and dignitaries say a few words in tribute to the founders of this great organization and to the organization itself.

OSIA was originally known as “Figli d’Italia” when founded on June 22, 1905 by Vincenzo Sellaro, M.D., and five other Italian immigrants. The idea behind Figli d’Italia was to create a support system for Italian immigrants to assist them with becoming U.S. citizens, educational opportunities, provide health and/or death benefits and to offer assistance with their assimilation in America.

Through the years up to and including the present, OSIA has: established free schools to teach English to immigrants; established orphanages and homes for the elderly, life/death insurance, credit unions, welfare societies and scholarship funds. OSIA members bought war bonds and war stamps to help support war efforts during World Wars I and II. In true Italian fashion, friendly competitions between lodges sprung up to see which lodge contributed the most money to the Red Cross.

To date, OSIA members have given more than \$164 million to educational programs, disaster relief, cultural advancement and medical research. May they continue doing these and other good works for their communities long into the future.

WEDNESDAY MASSES: Our Wednesday Mass at 12:10PM continues with the San Gennaro devotional prayer recited at the end.
