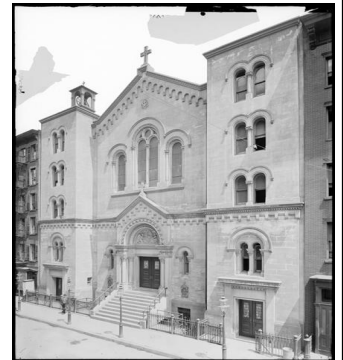

SAN GENNARO STATUE

REFURBISHING: The repair and refurbishing work of our two San Gennaro statues currently in the Shrine Room has been completed. The statues look brand new and are now in perfect condition. The two people blessed with the talent to accomplish this task so beautifully are Teddy Gregoris and his partner, Sera Salera. Teddy is a Little Italy 'native' who lived on Elizabeth Street growing up, so he really puts his heart and soul into whatever he volunteers to do for us here at Most Precious Blood Church. Sera is his equally dedicated 'right-hand'. Together they have done a magnificent job of repairing, repainting and overall refurbishing our San Gennaro statues. While here, they noticed that our St. Jude statue was in need of repair – a broken finger – which Teddy replaced, and then they teamed up again to repaint/polish him; St. Jude, too, is now in perfect condition. Again, words cannot adequately convey our gratitude to Teddy and Sera for the many long hours they spent here with results that far exceeded our expectations.
