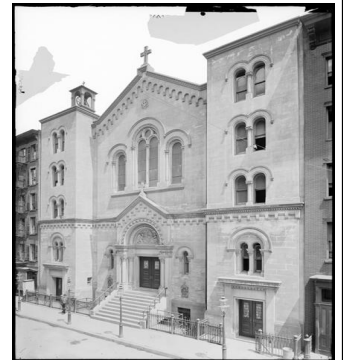

Mass will be offered on the weekdays of the Feast of San Gennaro, September 14-24. In addition to the regular weekday Mass at 12:10 PM (English), there will be a Mass in Italian at 6:00 PM. On Sunday Mass will be offered at 12:00 PM.



SAN GENNARO: The 91st Feast in Honor of San Gennaro, the patron saint of Naples, is upon us. We want to publicly thank Illuminations by Arnold for once again donating their beautiful chapel to us.
