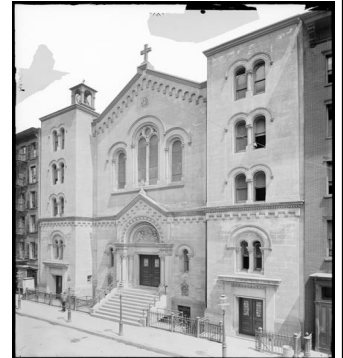

This painting was damaged a few months ago after torrential rain made its way into the church while a section of the roof was being repaired.
