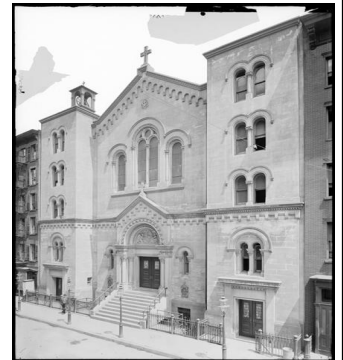

ADVENT/CHRISTMAS SEASON: Sunday, December 3rd, marks the beginning of Advent and the Christmas season. To usher in this joyous season, there will be two musical events at the Basilica of St. Patrick's Old Cathedral. For anyone who didn't see the flyer in last week's Bulletin: On Thursday, December 7 at 7:00PM, there will be a concert by Highbridge Voices, a children's choral program co-founded by Msgr. Sakano. The children will perform a medley of music traditionally associated with the Advent season. After the concert, at 8:00PM, there will be a reception in the Youth Center.



Sunday, December 10 at 5:30PM, there will be another concert by The Basilica Schola (adult choir), Basilica Voices (children's choir) and the St. Joseph's Handbell Choir. This concert will be followed by Mass at 7:00PM, and a reception at 8:00PM in the Parish House (263 Mulberry Street). These FREE events are open to all!

SAVING BUONGIORNO PROJECT: We are in the process of preserving the magnificent artwork which graces the walls and ceiling of our beautiful church. As we mentioned in previous weeks, the painting closest to the Lady of Lourdes Shrine is being worked on currently – it is being repaired and will then be cleaned, as will all the other works of art.
