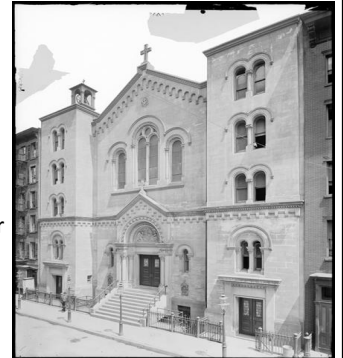

PEARL HARBOR REMEMBRANCE DAY:

Thursday, December 7, 2017 marks the 76th Anniversary of the attack on America's military base in Hawaii. The surprise attack took place on December 7, 1941 early in the morning. The attack lasted only 90 minutes, but the lives of 2,400 United States citizens were lost; there was no time to launch any defensive plan. There are many events planned for Remembrance Day which can be found on-line or via news media. However, the most important thing you can do on this day is to remember those who perished and to honor our military personnel. We are the 'Land of the Free' because of the brave – please don't ever forget that fact.



OUR SAINT MICHAEL STATUE has been returned to its proper niche after being repaired by Teddy Gregoris and Sera Salera. St. Michael was repaired in the San Gennaro shrine room and was returned to his niche by the men who were in our church repairing a damaged painting.
