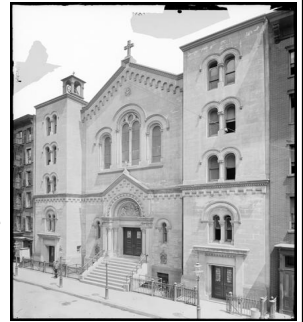

NEW LOCATION FOR CHURCH OFFICE

SAINT ANTHONY NOVENA: Tuesday, April 24, will be week #6 of our novena in honor of Saint Anthony of Padua. The novena is prayed immediately after the 12:10PM Mass and will continue until Tuesday, June 12th. Saint Anthony's feast day, June 13, falls on a Wednesday and, as such, will be celebrated at our weekly Wednesday 12:10PM Mass. Blessed Saint Anthony bread will be distributed at this Mass.

MADONNA DEL SOCCORSO DI SCIACCA: Some of you may have noticed that we have acquired a new statue of the Blessed Mother. Her official title is The Madonna Del Soccorso di Sciacca. The original chapel housing this beautiful Madonna was located on Elizabeth Street in Little Italy for generations. When the landlord sold the building and the new landlord took over, the rent became exorbitant (yes, even that far back) and the San Calogero Society was forced to vacate the premises. Thankfully, the Italian American Museum agreed to accept this Madonna into their establishment. She has been 'visiting' with them and all who came to the museum for the past 10 years. Now that the Museum is about to undergo major renovations, the Madonna once again finds herself in need of a new home. Thanks to sustained efforts by Angel Marinaccio, a descendant of an original society member, and the blessings of Monsignor Donald Sakano, The Madonna Del Soccorso di Sciacca has found a new, permanent home here at Most Precious Blood; she can be found immediately outside the Lady of Lourdes Shrine on the Baxter Street side of the church.

The Madonna is in need of repair. Once again, our resident master of saint renovations, Teddy Gregoris, has stepped up to do whatever is necessary to restore the Madonna to her full and total glory. He has already repaired and polished her crown to perfection and is waiting to get started on whatever comes next.

As we've mentioned numerous times in the past, neither Teddy nor his partner, Sera Salera, ever accept any monies for all the work they perform for us at MPB, and this is no exception. Having grown up on Elizabeth Street close to the chapel and having family members who were a part of the original society provide an extra layer of love and dedication for the Madonna in Teddy's heart.

We also must acknowledge Stephen LaRocca, the President of the San Rocco Society, for the work he did in securing the transition and insuring that the Madonna remains part of the San Calogero Society for many years to come. Information on becoming a member of the newly-formed San Calogero Society, and the Mass on June 16 in honor of these two statues, will follow.
